Hunter moved to the UK over 20 years ago and has entrenched himself in not only television, but the stand-up circuit around the country and at festivals, making this live performance an assured slice of professional brilliance.

Three-time Perrier Award-nominated, he reached the final of *So You Think You Are Funny* in 1998 during his first visit to the Edinburgh Festival Fringe. He was also nominated for The Edinburgh Comedy Awards Best Newcomer in 2002 with his debut full-length show, *I Am What I Am*. Awards aplenty followed with accolades across the board for his meticulous, witty approach to modern life.
