#### **LIGHTING**

Permanent fixed lighting rig on fixed dead hung internally wired bar consisting LED RGB wash, Gobo Break Up wash, Cold and Warm wash from Front of House. 3 colour wash (Blue, Pink and Amber), Gobo Breakup and Open White wash overhead
